

## SLURRY SEAL PROJECT UPDATE

The next phase of the City's pavement improvement program is scheduled for Thursday May 8 and Friday May 9. This phase involves the application of a slurry mixture over the recently applied chip seal.

It is important to note that this process requires SEVERAL HOURS to set up or dry. Once it is applied, it can not be driven on until it has set, approximately 3 or 4 hours.

All residents should have received a green flyer with information about parking restrictions and hours. If you have an appointment during the day, consider making a day of it, add other errands and out of house activities to extend your time, if practical.

For those that anticipate needing to come and go during the day it will be necessary to park a car outside the designated work zone for that day and walking to and from the car. Parking will be allowed on those project streets that ARE NOT part of the scheduled work area, even if posted with construction No Parking signs. Cars parked within the scheduled work area for that day will be towed.

Emergency vehicles will be allowed access at all times.

The following streets are scheduled to be closed and resurfaced on

Janor Court  
Twin Creeks from the bridge near Quito to Alma Jo Court.

Via Pinto  
Chadbourne Lane  
Tamson Court

The following streets are scheduled to be closed and resurfaced on  
**FRIDAY MAY 9:**

Stratford Court  
Via Vaquero  
Bancroft Avenue  
Via Caballero from Alma Jo Court to Daves Avenue

Alma Jo Court  
Via Encantada  
City Hall and Post Office parking lot

Please turn off your irrigation system the night before work is scheduled on your street if there is any chance that water will drain onto the street. We apologize for any inconvenience that this project may cause.

Be advised that this is the projected schedule that the contractor has devised and it may be necessary to alter it due to mechanical breakdown or other factors not in the control of the City. If any major change occurs we will make every reasonable effort to keep you informed.
