

RESOLUTION NO. 3672

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTE SERENO
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A JOINT POWERS
AGREEMENT FORMING THE WEST VALLEY CLEAN WATER PROGRAM
AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, in September 1994, the cities of Campbell, Monte Sereno, and Saratoga and the Town of Los Gatos (the "Member Agencies") were among the members of a Cooperative Agreement for stormwater pollution control coordination; and

WHEREAS, the coordinated stormwater pollution abatement, control and management effort of the Member Agencies is now commonly known as the West Valley Clean Water Program; and

WHEREAS, the West Valley Clean Water Program has been a successful and cost-effective means of collaboratively addressing federal and state stormwater requirements and regulations within the Member Agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Member Agencies now desires to form a Joint Powers Authority to continue the West Valley Clean Water Program as a separate legal entity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Monte Sereno hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the Joint Powers Agreement forming the West Valley Clean Water Program Authority.
