

RESOLUTION NO. 3667

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTE SERENO
PLACING THE HOUSE LOCATED ON THE PROPERTY AT 18240 DAVES AVENUE
ON THE CITY'S HISTORICAL INVENTORY**

WHEREAS, the City of Monte Sereno (the "City"), pursuant to Title 12, Chapter 1, of the Monte Sereno Municipal Code ("the Code") has adopted a Historical Inventory (the "Inventory") to identify features, artifacts or buildings that reflect the history of the City; and

WHEREAS, under the Code, the City's Cultural Commission or the property owner can nominate a property or feature of a property to be included on the Inventory; and

WHEREAS, the owner of the property located at 18240 Daves Avenue (the "Property") has nominated the house located on the Property to be included on the Inventory; and

WHEREAS, the house is an example of a rare Spanish Colonial Revival design constructed of adobe brick circa 1938, and represents a unique design and construction techniques; and

WHEREAS, the structure served as the home of Mr. David L. Noble from 1960-2004, a resident of Monte Sereno who is recognized as a significant contributor to the development of the floppy disk.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTE SERENO resolves that the property at 18240 Daves Avenue be placed on the Historical Inventory.


